DECLARE THE EXISTENCE OF A NATIONAL EMERGENCY

I, GRAND CHIEF SIR BOB DADAE, GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 228 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby declare the existence of a National Emergency in the provinces and districts which were affected by the natural disaster, the 7.5 magnitude earthquake on the 28th February, 2018 including Southern Highlands, Hela, Western, Gulf and others with effect on and from 1st March, 2018.

Organic Law on the Calling of Meetings of the Parliament

RECALLING OF MEETING OF THE PARLIAMENT

I, GRAND CHIEF SIR BOB DADAE, GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 124 of the Constitution and Section 2(1)(a)(ii) of the *Organic Law on the Calling of Meetings of the Parliament*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, being of the opinion that exceptional circumstances justify the urgent recalling of Parliament to set on the 27th March, 2018 commencing at 2:00 pm to consider the Emergency Laws in relation to the existence of the National Emergency in the Southern Highlands, Hela, Gulf, Western and other provinces due to the 7.5 magnitude earthquake disaster.
