Kala Aufa officially sworn-in as Clerk of Parliament

THU 08.10.2020 | CLERK of Parliament, Kala Aufa was officially sworn into office by the Governor-General of Papua New Guinea Grand Chief Sir Bob Dadae during an investiture ceremony at the Government House today.

Mr Aufa who has served 23 years with the Parliamentary Service in various capacities, including acting Clerk for six years, expressed his appreciation to the National Executive Council (NEC) for the confidence in appointing him to be custodian of the Office of the Clerk of Parliament.

“I am humbly grateful to God for this opportunity,” he said. “I would also like to give credit to all the fore bearers of this honourable office... they have in one way or another; mentored, guided, trained, helped and inspired me into becoming the Clerk of Parliament, I am today.”

With the invaluable support and commitment of the staff and senior management team of the Parliamentary Service, Mr Aufa said he looked forward to leading and managing the affairs of the Service for the next six (6) years.

“I am ready to serve the people of Papua New Guinea and work with the Speaker and Members of this 10th Parliament and thereafter, to ensure that this national institution continues to serve its purpose in accordance to the Constitution of this great nation,” he said.

Mr Aufa is the sixth Clerk to be appointed by NEC.
