- 1 The Parliament met at two o'clock p.m. according to the terms of the resolution of Friday 15, February 2013. The Speaker (Mr Theo Zurenuoc) took the Chair and read Prayers.
- 2 **DEATH OF MEMBER (MR LUDWIG SCHULZE, MP) – LAST RESPECTS:**  
*Admission of pall-bearers:* With the concurrence of the Parliament, the pall-bearers carrying the casket containing the body of late Mr Ludwig Schulze were admitted into the Chamber.  
*Condolence motion:* Mr Peter O'Neill (Prime Minister) moved – That this Parliament expresses its deep regret at the death on 8 March 2013 of Mr Ludwig Schulze (Member for Angoram), and places on record its appreciation of his long and meritorious public service and tenders its profound sympathy to his family in their bereavement.  
Mr Belden Namah (Leader of the Opposition), having seconded the motion and other members having addressed the Parliament in support thereof -  
Debate ensued.  
Question – put and passed, motion agreed to.  
  
As a mark of respect to the memory of the late honourable Member, all Members present stood in silence.

The casket containing the body of late Mr Ludwig Shulze was removed from the Chamber.

- 3 **ADJOURNMENT:** Mr James Marape (Leader of Government Business) moved –  
That the Parliament do now adjourn.
