Tuesday, 6 May, 2014

- 1 The Parliament met at two o'clock p.m. pursuant to the terms of the resolution of 21 February 2014. The Speaker (Mr Theo Zurenuoc) took the Chair and in accordance with Standing Order 34, invited Mr Bob Dadae (Member for Kabwum) to say Prayers.
- 2 **BROADCASTING OF PARLIAMENTARY PROCEEDINGS – STATEMENT BY THE SPEAKER:** The Speaker informed the Parliament that the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on Broadcasting of Parliamentary Proceedings met this day and resolved that the National Broadcasting Corporation would be allowed to broadcast live questions without notice for the duration of this meeting.
